PLEASE READ:

* You will be assigned two 5-6 hour shifts in exchange for a Weekend Park Pass.

* A deposit of \$125 is required (check or credit card).

The deposit will only be retained by the Telluride Jazz Celebration:

- 1) If you use the weekend pass and DO NOT complete the required shifts.
- 2) If you are accepted as a volunteer and become unable to participate, you must notify Linda Shapiro by Friday, July 30, 2010.

* Night venue wristbands may be purchased for \$40. This wristband allows you to get into all night venue shows at 10 minutes prior to scheduled show times after Patrons, Sponsors, and Media are admitted. Please note that we do not deposit your check or charge your credit card unless we are required to retain your deposit.

I hereby wish to be a volunteer for the 2010 Telluride Jazz Celebration and agree to the following:

1. To enclose a check or credit card # for \$125 that will act as a deposit against the completion of my shifts.

If you submit a check, it will be destroyed upon the confirmation of the completion of my shifts.

If you do not satisfactorily complete your shifts this check will be deposited.

If you submit your credit card, the card will only be charged if you do not satisfactorily complete your shifts.

I hereby understand that neither the Telluride Jazz Celebration, nor any of its officers, employees, or volunteers shall be held liable for any claims seeking damages for personal injury or property damage that may arise out of your participation as a volunteer for the festival. I also hereby agree to indemnify the Telluride Jazz Celebration, its officers, employees, volunteers, and the Town of Telluride, harmless on account of any such claims.

2010 Telluride Jazz Celebration Festival Volunteer Application - Positions

We have positions in the following areas. Please number in order of preference. Jobs will be filled on a first come, first serve basis. Please note that some jobs may extend before and/or after the event dates.

- () Drivers Volunteers will shuttle artists and necessary supplies. Volunteers will be expected to furnish car or truck as required. Check which asset you have.
() Van () Truck () Car
- () Office: Volunteers will assist in the office prior and during the festival.
- () Park Set-Up: Volunteers will assist setting up fences, tents, tables, tarps, ticket booth, etc. in the Park. Times are pre and post-event.
- () Set Design : Volunteers will help make and hang signs and set up night venues.
- () Box Office : Volunteers will be responsible for selling tickets and exchanging previously paid tickets for wristbands.
- () Catering Assistants : Volunteers will assist the caterer in the Patron/VIP area. You must be 21 years of age for this assignment. You will need to provide ID for this position.
- () Stage Crew : Volunteers will be on stage moving equipment and setting up the outdoor stage.
- () Security : Volunteers are stationed at checkpoints and will be ticket-checking in the park.
- () Liquor & Beer Booth : Volunteers are responsible for selling refreshments at the Brew-Note Cafe located in the Park. You must be 21 years of age for this assignment and have had at least 2 years experience bartending. You will need to provide ID for this position.
- () Memorabilia : Selling posters and T-shirts and memorabilia in the park or office.
- () Ushers : Assist venue managers in night clubs.
- () Park Take-Down : Volunteers will take down fencing, tents, tables, ticket booth and tarps, etc. and they will clean up the park grounds.
